### **ENERGY POLICY STATEMENT**

GRAHAM recognise that climate change is emerging as one of the most serious environmental challenges currently threatening the global community. We understand that there is a need to minimise Greenhouse gas emissions produced as a result of fossil fuel consumption and we acknowledge that we have a role to play in tackling these issues.

The specific energy efficient practices which GRAHAM are committed to at all levels within the Company are as follows:

- To encourage energy awareness amongst employees through posters and training

- To monitor energy usage against agreed targets where adequate metering is available
- Where it is appropriate, to produce energy saving action plans and keep staff informed of progress

- To switch off appliances when not in use
