Job Description

The Water Hygiene Technician shall

- undertake monthly routine monitoring of building water services as part of a Legionella Control Program in accordance with HSC ACoP L8
- the role will involve working in a multi site capacity across Southern Scotland
- the inspections will be undertaken using a PDA and web based electronic log book system
- the inspections will involve temperature testing of water outlets, inspection of cold water storage tanks and hot water storage vessels, water sample collection and showerhead disinfection
- the successful candidate will be required to undertake in associated remedial works such as tank disinfections, tank relining etc.

This job description is intended to give the post holder an appreciation of the role envisaged for the Water Hygiene Technician and the range of duties to be undertaken. It does not attempt to detail every activity. Specific tasks and objectives will be agreed with the post holder at regular intervals.
