Construction update

We are pleased to inform you that works so far have been progressing well.

Clydebank and Yoker

Earlier in the summer we completed construction of a new open-air water channel, replacing the existing outfall which was moved to make way for the bridge positioning.

We are progressing the new bridge connection road on the north side which will join onto Dock Street. Its alignment and a new roundabout are now visible and once complete, the road surfacing will be carried out towards the end of the project.

At the riverside, we're continuing works preparing for the bridge pier foundations and will be mobilising barges and a crane as we build a layby berth on the Clyde.

We're also working with Scottish Power Energy Networks to install the connections which will provide power for the bridge plant room and enable the bridge to open and close to river traffic.

Renfrew

Construction of the new road from Argyll Avenue to the bridge is going well with drainage works underway.

Steel works are started on the south side of the river for the bridge pier and over the coming months we'll be continuing to deliver the drainage, new road kerbing and complete the pier works.

Bridge construction

Fabrication of the bridge is nearing completion with painting of both sections underway. We will be installing the two sections of the bridge in 2024.

Invest in Renfrewshire provide training, employability and job search support for Renfrewshire residents and have become an important delivery partner for GRAHAM.

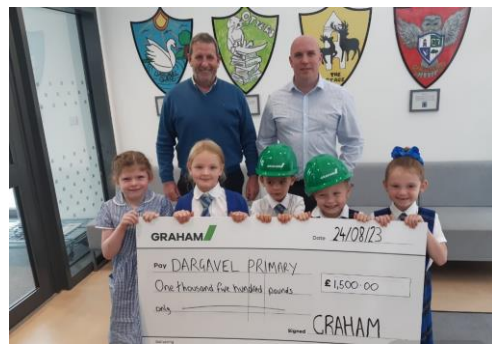
The visitors enjoyed an overview of the project and a construction careers presentation before heading out on site to gain a better understanding of how a live site operates.
